

No doubt Croy Creek is an intermittent stream (from my perspective), however with regards to jurisdictional status my past experience with the County has been they assumed jurisdiction on waterways depicted as perennial on USGS maps, and which convey flow for a time period during the year.

USACE will assume jurisdiction on intermittent streams if they have continuous flow at least seasonally (e.g. typically three months) and are connected to jurisdictional waters (Big Wood River). Specific to Corps requirements often times it can save the applicant time and money to assume the waterway is jurisdictional and permit accordingly than work through the process of a significant nexus evaluation and petition for a jurisdictional determination to be made by the Corps.

Hi Chuck and Trent,
We are trying to establish whether Croy Creek is considered an intermittent stream and thus non-jurisdictional. I saw reference of a letter from Terry Blau from the old Croy Creek PUD appl. stating the water running through the property are considered drainages and are non-jurisdictional, but haven't been able to track down that letter (see below). Kathy Grotto has a map depicting Croy as perennial. I believe Little Rock creek may also be non-jurisdictional. Could you provide me with any information re. the status of the creeks?

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
