
Hi Nancy and Tom,

Tom Alexander and Howard Royal both went through the plan documents. It appears the proposed building location is placed to the far end of the building envelope away from the District's property. The open end of the courtyard area and most of the outside kennels are also oriented away from the proposed elementary school location, which should mitigate noise concerns.

We are assuming you will not be asking the school district to participate in running water and sewer to the location at this time. If that is incorrect, please be sure to let us know.

If these assumptions are correct, we do no plan to offer any statements in regards to this project.
