EXECUTIVE SESSION – IDAHO CODE §67-2345 1(d) INDIGENT HEARING

Pursuant to Statutory Provisions, the Board of Blaine County Commissioners (BCC) met this day at 11:00 a.m. Present were: Vice-Chairman Angenie McCleary; Commissioner Jacob Greenberg; Blaine County Clerk JoLynn Drage; Blaine County Chief Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Tim Graves, Blaine County Indigent Services Manager Brooke Roberson; Blaine County Indigent Services Assistant Amy Rivkin; and Senior Deputy DiAnne Shrum. No one representing the appellant was present.

Vice Chairman McCleary called the meeting to order at 11:02 a.m.

**Greenberg moved, seconded by McCleary, to convene in Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code 67-2345 1(d) to consider an indigent medical application. Greenberg (aye) and McCleary (aye). Motion carried 2/0.**
