Wind Energy Facilities Ordinance: Title 9, Zoning Regulations: Continued from December 15, 2009; Public hearing on and consideration of: AN ORDINANCE OF BLAINE COUNTY, IDAHO, AMENDING BLAINE COUNTY CODE, TITLE 9, ZONING REGULATIONS BY ESTABLISHING CHAPTER 3A, relating to UTILITIES FACILITIES, specifically wind energy facilities, including definitions, location and use regulations and conditional use standards of evaluations in Blaine County, Idaho; stating the findings and reasons for the ordinance; and providing a severability clause and an effective date.
