- **CONTINUATION OF SILVER CREEK'S KILPATRICK POND STREAM ALTERATION PERMITS PUBLIC HEARINGS:** Picabo Livestock Co. Inc. proposes the discharge of concrete, dirt, rock, and dredged material below the ordinary high water mark of Silver Creek on the east side of the Kilpatrick Rd. Bridge to replace an irrigation diversion dam, construct a fish passage, construct a temporary coffer dam, remove excess sediment from approximately 1100 feet of channel, construct 2.8 acres of wetlands, and riprap the outlet of a temporary bypass channel. **The Nature Conservancy** proposes to alter Silver Creek and adjacent wetlands by discharging dredged and fill dirt material below the ordinary high water mark of approximately 2500 linear feet of stream and 2.56 acres of wetland by narrowing the channel to reduce thermal loading, promote sediment transport of incoming materials while maintaining the existing legacy sediment on site and create wetland habitat on their property on the west side of the Kilpatrick Rd. Bridge. The two projects are intended to work in conjunction with each other and are located within Sections 25 and 30 of Township 1 South, Range 19 and 20 East, in Blaine County, near Picabo, immediately east and west of the Kilpatrick Rd. Bridge. **Authorizations for the proposals have been issued by the US Army Corps of Engineers and the Idaho Department of Water Resources.**
