CASE #2015-68 MEDICAL INDIGENT APPEAL HEARING

McCleary moved, seconded by Greenberg, to go into Executive Session, pursuant to Idaho Code §74-206 1(d) to consider indigent medical records exempt from disclosure. Motion carried 2/0.
