




Bellevue Triangle & Foothills Subarea

Cities or Towns	Unincorporated communities of Gannett, Picabo and West Magic. Rural residential and farms in the "triangle".
Public Lands	55% managed by the BLM and 6% State. No USFS land. 44% private.
Geography	Foothills surrounding farm land and small rural communities. Silver Creek and many spring-fed tributaries and associated wetlands.

Recreation

Activities Overview	Silver Creek Preserve world class fly-fishing, waterfowl hunting and birding destination. Road biking in the Bellevue Triangle and surrounding rural roads; water sports on Magic Reservoir; some hiking and mountain biking; hunting on public and private lands. Shooting at Wood River Gun Club. Non-motorized and limited motorized/snowmobiling recreation in Rock Creek Ranch.
Primary Recreation Sites & Facilities	Silver Creek Preserve. Hayspur Fish Hatchery and campground. small number of camp sites at Stanton Crossing. Magic Reservoir; portion of West Magic airstrip. Rock Creek Ranch conservation area. Small public park in Picabo.
Rivers, Streams, and Lakes	Silver Creek and multiple spring-fed tributaries, Lower Big Wood, Magic Reservoir, Rock Creek.

County Services Related to Recreation

Waterways	Multiple docks and boat launches on Magic Reservoir
Marine Patrol	Magic Reservoir
Leased Land	5 acres leased by Blaine County for Wood River Gun Club
Snowmobile	Groomed trails at Croy Creek, Hatty Gulch, Rock Creek and Glendale Road
Road & Bridge	Road biking Gannett Road and various County roads within the Bellevue Triangle. West Magic road operations shared with Camas County.
