The degree of traffic would transform our community in a very negative way and when we bought property here we were investing in a residential, not a commercial, area. I am particularly concerned to hear that there is an effort to bypass P and Z in the review process. Camp Rainbow Gold is a fine institution and we support its efforts to provide support for cancer patients and their families.
