Subject: Questions for Idaho Power redundant line applicant

Dear Planning and Zoning Commissioners,

During the October 20th workshop, the Blaine County P&Z staff indicated that the public could submit questions to the County regarding the proposed redundant transmission line.

Please direct the following questions to Idaho Power:

1. For the proposed section between Buttercup road and the Wood River sub station there will be two circuits. Will there ever be more than 138KV traveling along this section?
2. Will it be possible that the two circuits create a higher EMF reading than current existing conditions directly under the power line?
3. Is it possible for the wires to fail and fall to the ground due to extreme weather events or other circumstances? If so generally speaking how often has this happened?
4. Is the underground option inherently safer?
