
As you may, or may not know, Camp Rainbow Gold is preparing an application for a CUP for a commercial complex 7 1/2 miles out East Fork. The plans for this facility include 23-30 buildings, and a bed count of 200. There has already been the first of two public rallies held by CRG regarding this project, as well as a meeting at the courthouse on July 28th. 80+ residents of East Fork have attended these first meetings to voice their concerns.

It is in the best interest of all involved that CRG be held to the standard procedure that would have them present their application first to the P&Z. There is some concern that they would try to bypass the P&Z, and go directly before the Commissioners. This would allow CRG to avoid the scrutiny of the P&Z, and eliminate the public comments that go with those P&Z public meetings. This is a large project that will have a lasting impact on many people. Allowing CRG to circumvent the P&Z would be a gross injustice to the public, especially the residents/voters of East Fork. Let the P&Z do it's job.
