

July 8-10th Clinic and One Day Competition (estimated 30 riders)


July 29-31st Pony Club Camp and Rally Competition (estimated 40 riders)

- On all entries, emails and social media communications prior to events/shows, the organizers and Board of the Winter Sun Horse Park will provide clear driving directions that include posted speed limits for Broadford Road, Lower Broadford Road and Townsend Gulch Road. We will request, in the above communications, that all visitors respect the speed limits and our neighbors by driving slowly and with courtesy when coming and going from the Horse Park.
- The Board of the Winter Sun Horse Park will provide signage at three locations, as indicated on the provided map. The first sign will be posted as you turn onto Lower Broadford Road from the Broadford Bridge. This sign will ask visitors to the Horse Park to PLEASE SLOW DOWN and RESPECT our NEIGHBORS.
- There will be a sign posted at the exit of the Horse Park driveway that asks all visitors, leaving the Horse Park, to drive slowly and observe the 25mph speed limit on our neighborhood roads.
- The Board of the Horse Park will also post a sign at the NORTH end of Lower Broadford Road alerting drivers of horse trailers to use caution making the right hand turn onto the bridge. Yield to oncoming bridge traffic. This turn is sharp and longer trailers must swing wide and cross into the oncoming lane. The bridge should be clear before making the turn.
