





Hailey & Bellevue Canyons Subarea	
Cities or Towns	Includes the cities of Hailey (County seat) and Bellevue, and adjacent canyons with rural and semi-rural residential. Friedman Memorial Airport located within the City of Hailey.
Public Lands	58% managed by the BLM, 6% State land, and just 1% US Forest Service. 34% private land.
Geography	Broadening Wood River Valley floor surrounded by foothills.

Recreation	
Activities Overview	Hiking, biking, and Nordic skiing on popular near-town trails. Fishing and tubing on the Big Wood River. Motocross biking out Croy Canyon. Alpine skiing at Rotarun. Multitude of activities within the cities including skate park, public swimming pool, bike pump park, various private health clubs and recreational facilities.
Primary Recreation Sites & Facilities	Southern terminus of Wood River Trail; Croy motocross track; Rotorun Ski Area; Croy Nordic Center, Muldoon Shooting range, equestrian facilities. Inside cities: city parks, Draper and Howard Preserves on the Big Wood River, BCRD facilities including outdoor pool, School District facilities and playing fields. (Recreation assets within city limits are not mapped.)
Rivers and Streams	Big Wood River, Croy Creek, Quigley Creek, Muldoon Creek

County Services Related to Recreation	
Road & Bridge	Croy Canyon and Broadford Roads used by road cyclists. Democrat, Quigley, Muldoon, Slaughterhouse, Lee, Townsend and Colorado Gulch Roads used heavily by mountain bikers and walkers, and some equestrians. Colorado Gulch and Broadford Road bridges used for swimming and fishing access.
Snowmobile	Snowmobile trails groomed out Quigley and Muldoon Canyons.
Leased Land	County land leased to Rotarun Ski Area, operating under Recreation Development Agreement.
Airport	Primary air access for out-of-town visitors with public and private air terminals.
