






Little Wood Subarea	
<b>Cities or Towns</b>	City of Carey. Established farms and ranches including isolated ranches higher in the Little Wood drainage.
<b>Public Lands</b>	30% BLM land, 22% US Forest Service, and 8% State. Less than 1% Bureau of Reclamation (40 acres). 40% private.
<b>Geography</b>	Remote Little Wood drainage with forested areas of the eastern Pioneer Mountains; farmland in the southern area around Carey.

Recreation	
<b>Activities Overview</b>	Fishing on Little Wood River and tributaries, and at reservoirs; hunting; camping at Little Wood Reservoir, motocross biking. Park and school activities within Carey.
<b>Primary Recreation Sites and Facilities</b>	Little Wood Reservoir dock, boat launch and campground; Fish Creek Reservoir shore launch; Carey Kimama Motocross Track; Carey Lake Wildlife Management Area. Gateway to Craters of the Moon National Monument. Undeveloped hot springs. Blaine County fairgrounds and rodeo grounds in Carey. <b>(Recreation assets within city limits are not mapped.)</b>
<b>Rivers, Streams, and Lakes</b>	Little Wood River and tributaries, Little Wood Reservoir, Carey Lake, Fish Creek and Reservoir, lower Silver Creek.

County Services Related to Recreation	
<b>Waterways</b>	Little Wood Reservoir dock and boat launch, Fish Creek shore launch
<b>Road &amp; Bridge</b>	County roads provide access to reservoirs and other water access points along Little Wood River
<b>County Fair</b>	County Fairgrounds and Rodeo Grounds in Carey.
