Dear Tom,

Thank you for attending the November 21, 2016 regular meeting of the Board of Directors. Your presentation on the proposed redundant power line project from the Hailey substation answered several questions that the Directors had.

As a result of our meeting, the following statements can be made:

- The Sun Valley Water & Sewer District fully supports the project, as it should diminish potential interruptions in the provision of sewer and water services due to electrical power failure, while also providing our customers with more reliable electrical service.
- The District is aware of, and generally open to, the various routings and scenarios (above and below ground) that you presented and discussed at our November 21 meeting, and understands that one or more power poles, lines or structures could be located on or above its property.
- The District is not opposed to granting any necessary line and structure easements on or across its property to facilitate the proposed line and related improvements, contingent on mutual agreement of appropriate terms and conditions, including those related to alignment, structure locations, maintenance and access.

In conclusion the District Board of Directors, at the meeting, expressed general support for Idaho Power's redundant power line proposal, and looks forward to working with you as the final details are established. Please keep us informed as Idaho Power negotiates and determines the final details for the project.
