9:30 ACTION ITEM:

Public Utility Facility Conditional Use Permit Application by Idaho Power Co.

Consideration of two appeals of the Planning & Zoning Commission's approval of a Public Utility Facility Conditional Use Permit Application by Idaho Power Co. to construct, maintain, and operate a 138-kV, overhead and underground, redundant transmission line from the Wood River Substation north of Hailey to the Ketchum Substation located on Sun Valley Rd. in Sun Valley. The transmission line is proposed to run east from the Wood River Substation to Buttercup Rd, then north along the west side of Buttercup Rd., and then north along the east side of Hwy. 75 until it crosses to the west side of Hwy. 75 north of the East Fork traffic light. This proposed line would then continue north along the west side of Hwy. 75 to Hospital Dr. and then along Hospital Dr. and the bike path to an undergrounding transition structure at the intersection of Hwy. 75 and Elkhorn Rd. This transmission line will range from 4' to up to 15' higher than the existing power lines along this route. The line is proposed to run through six different zoning districts before entering the Cities of Sun Valley and Ketchum.

No public comment will be taken at this meeting.
