JUVENILE DETENTION UPDATE

Third Day

Monday, March 15, 2021

Pursuant to Statutory Provisions, the Board of Blaine County Commissioners (BCC) met this day at 2:30 P.m. Present were Chairman Dick Fosbury, Commissioner Angenie McCleary (remotely), County Clerk JoLynn Drage; Outreach and Education Specialist Stephanie Carlson; Twin Falls County Commissioner Brent Reinke; and Juvenile Detention Manager Paul Shepherd.

Commissioner Greenberg was absent.

Commissioner Fosbury called the meeting to order at 2:43 p.m.

JUVENILE DETENTION UPDATE AND PRESENTATION BY TWIN FALLS COUNTY COMMISSIONER REINKE AND JUVENILE DETENTION MANAGER, PAUL SHEPHERD

Commissioner Brent Reinke explained that the Snake River Juvenile Detention Center is moving to the third floor of County West in Twin Falls. The move will locate the Center closer to services that are utilized by detainees.

Paul Shepherd provided detail about facilities that will be located near the new Detention Center, including crisis beds. The housing rate for detainees will increase from \$150 per day to \$195 per day. The visitors' desire was to ensure that counties who participate in the Joint Powers Agreement are prepared for the increase.

Commissioner McCleary asked several questions to clarify her understanding, and in the end supported the move.
