WOOD RIVER FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT SPECIAL BOND ELECTION

Shall the district be authorized to incur an indebtedness and issue and sell its general obligation bonds in the principal amount not to exceed \$17,000,000 to pay the cost of construction of a new fire station and improvements to existing facilities, the bonds to mature and to be payable from a levy of taxes for a term which may be less than but which shall not exceed twenty-five (25) years, all as more fully provided in ordinance no. 2021-01, adopted on August 18, 2021?

The purpose of the bond is for the construction of new fire station, renovation of existing facilities, with related equipment and improvements. The District has no existing indebtedness. The anticipated interest rate on the proposed bonds is 2.74% per annum. The total proposed principal amount to be repaid over the 25-year life of the bonds is \$17,000,000; the total interest anticipated to be paid over the life of the bonds, based on the anticipated interest rate, is \$7,180,900; the total amount to be repaid over the life of the bonds is \$24,180,900. The levy is proposed to generate approximately \$967,236 per year, which is generated by a tax of \$72.60 per one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.

The total amount to be repaid over the life of the proposed negotiable bonds, based on the anticipated interest rate, is \$1,044,400, consisting of \$950,000.00 in principal and \$94,400 of interest. The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed bonds is a tax of \$21 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.
