

Blaine County Adopt-A-Road Program



Terms, Conditions, and Acknowledgement

_____, hereinafter called Volunteer Group, wishes to perform volunteer activities on behalf of Blaine County, Idaho, as part of the Blaine County Adopt-A-Road Program. By signing this agreement, Volunteer Group, on behalf of all of its participants, agrees to the terms and conditions set forth herein, and acknowledges that the services provided under this Program are voluntary only and should in no way be construed as creating an employment relationship of any kind between Blaine County, Volunteer Group, and/or its individual members.

Blaine County will provide Volunteer Group with the following:

- Authorization to perform cleanup activities on a specified section of right of way within Blaine County.
- Special conditions for performing cleanup activities on a particular section of right of way.
- Safety vests, trash bags, and traffic control signs to be prominently placed on the right of way by Volunteer Group to alert motorists of the presence of Volunteer Group.
- After completion of the cleanup activities, installation of an Adopt-A-Road sign as near as possible to each end of the adopted section or contiguous sections. The signs will display the Volunteer Group's name or acronym as approved by Blaine County.
- Waiver of fees for any trash collected and disposed of at the Ohio Gulch Transfer Station by Volunteer Group.

Volunteer Group will provide the following:

- The contact information (name, daytime phone number, cell phone number, email address, and mailing address) for a member of Volunteer Group who will serve as their representative, and who is responsible for communicating with Blaine County representatives, attending any clean-up activities, notifying Blaine County and emergency responders in the event of an emergency, and ensuring that all volunteers are aware of the terms and conditions set forth herein.
- Communication with, and supervision of, all of those participating in the clean-up activities, including but not limited to: obtaining parental consent; notifying participants of these terms and conditions; notifying participants of the possible presence of dust, exhaust fumes, plant pollens, and sprays; warning participants to avoid handling hazardous materials (syringes, needles, drug paraphernalia, dead animals, toxic materials etc.); warning participants to avoid handling large or potentially dangerous items; and providing participants with safety training and medical care, including providing adequate first aid kits and drinking water.
- Notify Blaine County representatives about the presence and location of any hazardous substances, or large, dangerous or unusual items encountered during the clean-up activities, which shall not be moved or disturbed.
- Collect, bag, and dispose of all trash collected during clean-up activities at the Ohio Gulch Transfer Station.
- Return any unused bags, safety vests and traffic control signs to Blaine County following cleanup activities.
- Perform cleanup activities on the specified section of right of way at least twice per year, for a minimum of two years.

Volunteer Group agrees to comply with the following terms and conditions when performing cleanup activities as part of the Blaine County Adopt-A-Road Program:

- Obey and abide by all laws, and any terms and conditions required by Blaine County.
- Wear gloves, protective eyewear, and reflective safety vests at all times.

- Perform all cleanup activities in a safe and responsible manner.
- Refrain from picking up or disturbing any hazardous substances, or large, dangerous or unusual items encountered during clean-up activities.
- Prohibit all participants from possessing or consuming alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs.
- Provide continuous adult supervision for any participant(s) under the age of 18 years.
- Respect private property rights at all times.

Additional Terms and Conditions:

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Blaine County reserves the right to terminate or modify the Adopt-A-Road Program at any time for any reason. Blaine County, in its sole judgement and discretion, may remove Adopt-A-Road signs and/or take any other remedial action to respond to a violation of these terms and conditions by Volunteer Group or any of its participants.
